One contractual loan payment will be refunded to member's primary savings in May 2018.

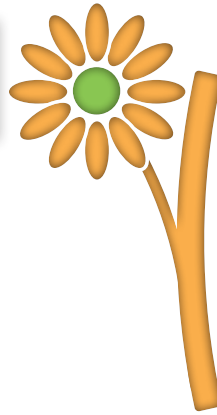

Fraud Corner

Protecting your PIN

When you're entering your PIN number while using your debit card, it's important to remember that although your PIN is a number or word only you know, it may be easier than you think for others to figure it out if you're not careful.

When creating your PIN, do not use a phrase or number that can be found in your wallet, like your birthdate, phone number, or a name. Always cover the keypad while entering your PIN number, because it's easy for people to sneak a peek from behind you or from another angle.

Also, never write your PIN down and don't share it with anyone; you should be the only one who knows it. If you follow these guidelines, you'll be taking important steps to protect yourself from debit and credit card fraud.
