- Essay requirements:
 - 800-1,000 words
 - Double spaced, 12-14 point font, single-sided
 - How this education will improve the student's individual life
 - How have you been involved in your community through volunteering and/or diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts
 - How this education will improve the student's community
 - Articulation of their financial need
 - Do not include your name on the essay itself

Immediate family of American 1 Credit Union staff and board members are not eligible for this scholarship.
